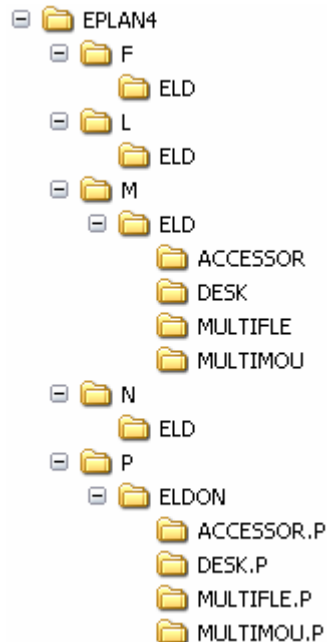




### Eld2Epl.exe contains the following structure:



E-plan4/F/	contains supporting forms for the projects (empty)
E-plan4/L/	contains the article-file "Eldon-articles-2006-EN.txt" (EN for English)
E-plan4/M/	contains the blocks for Desk, MultiFlex, MultiMount & Accessories
E-plan4/N/	contains supporting lay outs of the projects
E-plan4/P/	contains Eldon-projects for Desk, MultiFlex, MultiMount & Accessories.

#### Step 1:

- Extract Eld2Epl.exe to your E-plan4 –drive (C:/ or D:/ etc.) to add Eldon enclosures & Data to E-plan

#### Step 2:

- Open E-plan and choose for "Part", click "Management"
- Choose for "Eplan parts management", click "Import"
- Take option "Eplan-ASCII format"
  - select "Eldon-articles-2006-EN.txt"
  - click OK

#### Step 3:

In the article-manager you can see the result. The enclosure-part contains a folder called ELD which contains **all** the Eldon articles, including accessories.

#### Step 4:

Open the E-plan projects which contains a folder ELDON which contains the four Eldon projects. Open one of the projects. Each drawn enclosure or accessorie is already linked to the article-database. The articles were added to the front-view rectangle of each component. If you wish you can add accessories yourself by changing the article-list of the drawn front-view.
